This is a low intermediate course to develop writing skills and teach communication through writing. This course reviews simple and advanced verb forms, adjectives and adverbs. Emphasis is on sentence structure word order, word choice, sentence combining and punctuation. Students will build upon their sentence skills to develop a unified paragraph of at least seventy-five words in length utilizing topic sentences.
